




Jewish Cemetery Desecrated In France; 5 Teen Suspects Held

Evidence for the proposition that the Israeli state was the prime mover behind the events of 9-11

When an event occurs that that fundamentally changes the dynamics of global geopolitics, there is one question above all others whose answer will most assuredly point to its perpetrators. That question is "Cui bono?" If those so indicted are in addition found to have had both motive and means then, as they say in the US, it's pretty much a "slam-dunk".

And so it is with the events of 9/11.

Discounting the Official Narrative as the absurdity it so clearly is, there are just two organisations on the entire planet with the expertise, assets, access and political protection necessary to have both executed 9/11 and effected its cover-up to date (ie the means). Both are Intelligence Agencies - the CIA and the Israeli Mossad whose motives were arguably the most compelling. Those motives dovetailed perfectly with the Neocon PNAC agenda, with it's explicitly stated need for "...a catastrophic and catalyzing event - like a new Pearl Harbor" [1] in order to mobilise US public opinion for already planned wars, the effects of which would be to destroy Israel's enemies.

This article marshals evidence for the proposition that "Israel did it".

"Our concern in this issue is wholly biblical and is not to be confused with any political attitude towards the state of Israel.... Our hope in Christ's coming victory includes our hope for Israel in Christ, in his victory over the blindness of his own people."

Statement on the Hope of Israel

"What had happened?

"As the crucial vote was taken and I could clearly see from the platform what side the various national delegations were taking, I said to myself: the spectre of Hitler is present.... I saw that the churchmen from countries which had been... under the national socialist regime had practically all come to feel that Israel had not only a central place in the past history of salvation, but also in the future of salvation. As they had had to face the demonic hatred of the Jews, they had found deep meaning in St Pauls' interpretation of the destiny of Israel in the ninth, tenth and eleventh chapters of the Epistle to the Romans."

"Those who had not been so close to the terrible drama of the extermination of Jews in Europe could not see it this way. They felt that to single out the Jews, to give them a special place in history, was – in spite of all good intentions – a sort of discrimination.... The minority had to admit that before the days of Hitler they had practically all, including Karl Barth himself, interpreted St Paul's teaching... in a more or less allegorical rather than a historical way... [and were now]... motivated by shame that the churches had not understood in time the full spiritual dimension of the Jewish question."


"...we had as yet no common mind about the theological questions of the destiny of the Jewish people or about the deeper significance of the creation of the state of Israel." Visser 'T Hooft, *Memoirs*, 313-314. In August 1969, the Central Committee of the WCC meeting in Canterbury, England, issued a statement calling upon theologians "to avoid the misuse of the Bible in support of partisan political views".

"For the first time in an official WCC policy statement, there was explicit recognition of Palestinian national identity."


